Anchorage Land Excursions

Glacier and Wildlife Flightseeing Tour

Take off over the expansive Knik Glacier rimmed with spectacular hanging glaciers. Sense the motion of the ice and how it has shaped the land, and then fly over the winding Knik Glacier Gorge. Spot mountain goats and moose followed by a landing at a lakeside inn for refreshments.

Cost: **\$250** per person for 1 1/2 hours; or **\$300** per person for 2 1/2 hours with Lakeside Stop
\$100 per person for 30 minutes Anchorage Flightseeing Safari
\$345 per person for 2 1/2 hours Prince William Sound Glacier Flightseeing Tour

Redoubt Bay Bear Viewing

This guided tour will fly 70 miles southwest of Anchorage to the entrance of Lake Clark Wilderness Preserve, home of Redoubt Bay Lodge and incredible bear viewing. An experienced natural history guide will take you by boat through bear country where you can watch for bears as they fish for salmon. And don't forget to look for other wildlife along the way! Relax and enjoy a homemade lunch on the lake or in a cozy lodge before you return to Anchorage in the afternoon. (Seasonal between June 1 and August 15)

Cost: **\$605** per Person

Anchorage Day Hiking Half Day

Enjoy the long Alaskan summer days by hiking in the beautiful Chugach Mountains from Anchorage. Our hikes include transportation from downtown Anchorage hotels to trailhead, a guided naturalist hike in the valleys and peaks surrounding Anchorage, bear protection, bottled waters and snacks, trekking poles and extra attire (as needed). Each hike is tailored to your hiking and fitness levels. This half-day hike operates in all weather conditions.

Cost: **\$89** per adult; **\$69** per child

Helicopter Dog Sled Tour

Mush, mush! A helicopter is used to transport you to our alpine camp where our experienced guide will accompany you as you mush along a snow-covered glacier. Drive the sled yourself or enjoy the ride with an expert as you take in the dramatic scenery. Back at camp you can bundle yourself up in actual Iditarod racing gear including an original bib-number for a once in a lifetime photo opportunity. You will learn about Alaskan Huskies and the legendary Alaska dog mushing Seavey family.

Cost: **\$479** per person

Nature Hike

This guided 3 hour round trip hike explores the Historic Iditarod Trail. Your naturalist will point out and discuss flora and fauna of North America's northern-most temperate rainforest. Opportunities include blueberry picking in season and a unique hand tram crossing over Winner Creek Gorge.

Cost: **\$69** per adult; **\$59** per child

Alpine Hike on Alyeska Glacier

Ride the Scenic Alyeska Tram up to 2,300 feet & back down to the Alyeska Hotel near sea level. From the upper mountain tram, this guided glacier hike follows a scenic ridgeline surrounded by seven glaciers of the Girdwood Valley. This is a moderate to strenuous glacier hike with 800' elevation gain in 2 hours.

Cost: **\$139** per adult • Minimum Age: 12

Canyoneering

Journey to Alaska's gold rush for canyoneering, rappelling and prospecting at Crow Creek Gold Mine in Glacier Valley. Adventure into the remote dry creek canyon sculpted by hydro-mining utilizing harnesses, ropes, gloves, helmets and ladders to reach destinations including a thundering waterfall, caves and mossy canyons

Cost: **\$139** per adult • Minimum Age: 12.

Backcountry Jetboat

This is a thrilling jet boat adventure on the Twenty Mile River Valley where glaciers flow from snowcapped mountains and stunning scenery surrounds you. Your boat captain will navigate log strewn channels, twists and turns of the glacier river with viewing opportunities of bald eagles and salmon.

Cost: **\$169** per adult; **\$119** per child

Scenic Float

This scenic float offers panoramic glacier views while rafting through the Portage Valley. For an additional **\$30** per person, enjoy a Salmon BBQ Dinner along the shore of the glacial fed river.

Cost: **\$139** per adult; **\$60** per child (add an additional **\$30** per person for Salmon BBQ dinner)

Denali National Park Land Excursions

Husky Homestead

Step back from the crowds and join an intimate group for a personal tour of the homestead kennel of two-time Iditarod Champion Jeff King. Meet champion sled dogs, visit with puppies and see summer training in action. 1 1/2 hour narrated kennel tour.

Cost: \$59 per adult; \$39 per child

Denali Park Dinner Theater

Enjoy a night of fun, food & frivolity! Go back in time and join a group of unforgettable characters as they treat you to hilarious stories of living in Denali National Park featuring foot-stomping, knee-slapping music. The all-you-can-eat family style meal will let you feast on Alaska salmon, BBQ ribs, potatoes, corn on the cob, baked beans, salad, sourdough rolls and a tasty dessert.

Cost: \$63 per person; \$32 per child

Whitewater Rafting the Nenana River

With approximately two hour on the water, the Canyon Run is an exciting whitewater adventure with Class III and IV rapids. This is one ride where you might get wet!

Cost: \$99 per person

Wilderness Float Trip on the Nenana River

A 2-hour float trip on the Nenana River makes the scenic Wilderness Run perfect for the family and travels 13 miles through the Alaska wilderness. Perfect for the beginning rafter!

Cost: \$99 per person

Mt. McKinley by Helicopter!

Get an up close view of Mt. McKinley, the Great One!

Enjoy a helicopter thrill as you soar high above the land and view wildlife, alpine glaciers, the Alaska Range and Mt. McKinley from afar (weather dependent). This tour is highly recommendable for our “once in a lifetime” adventurers.

Cost: \$344 – per person- 50 minutes Denali Excursion

\$444- per person- 75 minutes Denali Glacier Landing Expedition

\$479 per person- 3 1/2 to 4 hours Heli-Hiking Adventure

Fixed Wing in Denali

Travel like the Bush pilots of Alaska!

Enjoy a 60-70 minute fixed wing flightseeing journey following the Alaska Range out to about one mile from Mt. McKinley (weather dependent). This is the flightseeing trip to do if you want to see North America’s highest peak.

Cost: \$375 per adult; \$190 per child

Tundra Wilderness Tour

Go deep into Denali National Park and search for moose, bear, wolves, caribou and Dall sheep amongst a spectacular backdrop of valleys and mountains. This 6 to 8 hour tour (53 miles one way into the park) is led by experienced driver guides, which provide narrative on the many critters that call Denali home. With tales of Mt. McKinley and breathtaking photographic opportunities, this is one tour to be sure and reserve early! Price includes a snack box meal and beverage.

Cost: \$159 per adult; \$76 per child

Denali Natural History Tour

Travel into Denali National Park with a focus of the landscape, geology, and history in spectacular backdrop of valleys and mountains. This 4 to 5 hour tour (17 miles one way into the park) is led by experienced driver guides, which provide narrative on the many critters that call Denali home. Price includes a light snack and beverage.

Cost: \$98 per adult; \$47 per child

Guided Hike Denali

Interpretive guided hike in Denali. The round-trip distance for these hikes is 4 miles.

Denali Jeep Backcountry Safari

Take the wheel of a 4WD Jeep Wrangler and follow your guide on a spectacular off-road journey into Denali’s backcountry of Stampede Road, recently made popular by the movie “Into the Wild”.

Cost: \$145 per adult; \$97 per child

Denali ATV Wilderness Adventure

Get ready for some adventure! Whether a novice or an expert ATV-er, this tour will be a memorable ride in the scenic Alaskan wilderness. Choose from a Single or Side-by-Side ATV. Ride on several terrain types - coal mining tails, rocky creek beds, hill climbing, and water and mud crossings. Total tour covers about 10 miles. Minimum age to drive is 21.

Cost: \$95 per person with Single ATV. \$80 per person with side-by-side ATV. Double occupancy required.





Talkeetna Land Excursions

McKinley Flyer

Explore Mt. McKinley within six miles of this magnificent sight. Fly to the remote western end of Denali National Park and see the south side of Mt. McKinley, Mt. Foraker and Mt. Hunter. Fly over the winding Kahiltna glacier, the longest glacier in Denali National Park, and continue on to the climber's base camp located at 7200 feet on the southeast fork of the Kahiltna Glacier. (1-¹/₄ hours)

Cost: **\$265** per person

McKinley Flyer with Glacier Landing

Explore Mt. McKinley within six miles of this magnificent sight. Fly to the remote western end of Denali National Park and see the south side of Mt. McKinley, Mt. Foraker and Mt. Hunter. Fly over the winding Kahiltna glacier, the longest glacier in Denali National Park, and continue on to the climber's base camp located at 7200 feet on the southeast fork of the Kahiltna Glacier. Includes a glacier landing. (1-³/₄ hours)

Cost: **\$340** per Person

Summit Tour with Glacier Landing

This tour spends more time at higher altitudes and gives a broad overview of the Alaska Range. See the panoramic 500-mile Alaska Range unfold before you. Climb to over 20,000 feet and take in the dramatic view that only climbers see, while you fly over the summits of McKinley, Foraker and Hunter from the comfort of a turbine aircraft. Land on a glacier to complete this ultimate Alaskan adventure that few have the opportunity to experience. (2 hours)

Cost: **\$400** per Person



Wilderness Jet Boat Tour

This exciting 20-mile jet boat excursion whisks you into the heart of the wilderness in comfort. Along the riverbanks, you will take a ¹/₄ mile nature walk to visit an authentic trapper's cabin. Wildlife, folklore, artifacts, and panoramic views of Denali and the Alaska Range combine to make this an unforgettable and unique Alaskan river adventure.

Cost: **\$70** per adult; **\$53** per child (2 hours)

\$120 per adult; **\$90** per child for the Three Rivers Tour (3 hours)

\$165 per adult; **\$124** per child for the Devils Canyon Adventure Tour (5 hours)

Talkeetna River Float

The magnificent Talkeetna River features glacially fed, flat water (Class I) swift and cold, yet calming and serene. This portion of the river is good for all ages. Possible views of Denali, spawning salmon, and fresh water streams. A beautiful introduction into Alaska's wilderness as flora and fauna drape the river's banks and where eagles nest in the tree tops above.

Cost: **\$75** per adult; **\$49** per child

Zipline Tour

Combine great views of the Alaska Range and Denali with the thrill of ziplining. This is the farthest-north canopy tour in North America, and includes nine ziplines and three suspension bridges. Then hold on tight as you zip to the next amazing view! Participants must weigh between 90 – 270 pounds and be at least 10 years of age.

Cost: **\$149** per adult; **\$119** per child ages 10 to 12.
