## Passports

A valid Passport is required for all international travel.

A Passport or other Western Hemisphere Travel Initiative (WHTI) compliant document **will soon be** required on some U.S. Domestic sailings.

We strongly recommend that all guests travel with a valid Passport.

## Visas

<b>Brazil</b>	Visa must be obtained before leaving home.	Brazilian visas, regardless of the length of validity, must initially be used within 90 days of the issuance date or will no longer be valid. (The visa issuance date to the date the guest enters Brazil cannot exceed 90 days.) Immigration authorities will not allow entry into Brazil without a valid visa. <b>Turkey</b>	See Additional Visa Information.	Guests who sail in and sail out of a Turkish port do not require a visa. Visa only required for guests who embark or debark ship in a Turkish port. Visa may be obtained upon arrival at the Istanbul Airport for \$20.00 cash (subject to change) prior to boarding the ship.
