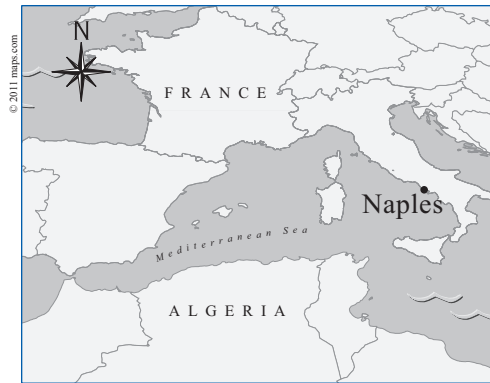

PORT EXPLORER and SHOPPING GUIDE

GENERAL INFORMATION Naples is the third largest city in Italy, with a population of over 1.5 million. It lies at the foot of a range of low hills on the west coast of southern Italy. Since the destruction inflicted during World War II, Naples has become an important industrial and commercial center. The Bay of Naples makes it Italy's second most important sea port, surpassed only by Genoa.

The Neapolitans have a great fondness for music and with such songs as 'Santa Lucia', 'O Sole Mio' and 'Funiculi Funicla', the City's music has become familiar throughout the world. The great tenor Enrico Caruso was a native of Naples.

Naples and the surrounding area attracts both tourists and artists with its wealth of historical monuments, its proximity to the beauty of the Amalfi Coast and the famous Isle of Capri, and the archaeological treasures of Pompeii and Herculaneum.

SHORE EXCURSIONS To make the most of your visit to Naples and its surrounding areas we suggest you take one of our organized Shore Excursions. For information concerning tour content and pricing consult your Shore Excursion Brochure or contact the Shore Excursion Desk. When going ashore, be advised to take with you only necessary items and secure any valuables onboard.

LOCAL CUSTOMS Bargaining: Most items have fixed prices, but it may be possible to get a discount on a large purchase. It is normal to bargain at markets and with street vendors.

Tippling: Generally a 15% service charge is added to restaurant bills, however, as this amount doesn't all go to the waiter, it is normal to offer a 5% tip to the waiter in addition to any service charge.

LOCAL CUISINE AND DRINK SPECIALTIES As pizza was invented in Naples there are plenty of authentic pizzerias to choose from. Try mozzarella and tomato served with fresh basil and liberally doused in olive oil as a starter. Spigola (Sea Bass) is the most popular of fish, served either steamed or baked. For dessert try Sfogliatella, a delicious clam-shaped Neapolitan pastry.

The local wine is Lacrima Christi (Christ's Tears) which comes from the slopes of Vesuvius. Strega is a popular liqueur, it has a rather unique flavor and is very powerful. Bottled water is recommended.

LOCAL CURRENCY The unit of currency in this port of call is the euro. There are 8 euro coins. All euro notes are legal tender in all countries of the euro area.

POST OFFICE AND TELEPHONE FACILITIES The main Post Office in Naples is located in Piazza Matteotti.

Telephone calls may be placed at the Telecom Italia Office. Most public telephones take coins and telephone cards which can be purchased at the Post Office or Tobacconists.

TOURIST INFORMATION The Tourist Information Office is located at Piazza Plebiscito.

TRANSPORTATION Taxis are generally available in front of the Ship's terminal. It is advisable to negotiate a fare before departing. Some taxi drivers may accept U.S. Dollars.

Jetfoils and ferries operate from Molo Beverello (#8), approximately 200 yards from the terminal, to Sorrento, Capri and Ischia. The alternative pier for hydrofoils is Mergellina, approximately 2 miles from the Ship's terminal.

A train service to Pompeii and Sorrento operates from Stazione Circumvesuviana, just off Corso Garibaldi, about 1 mile from the Port.

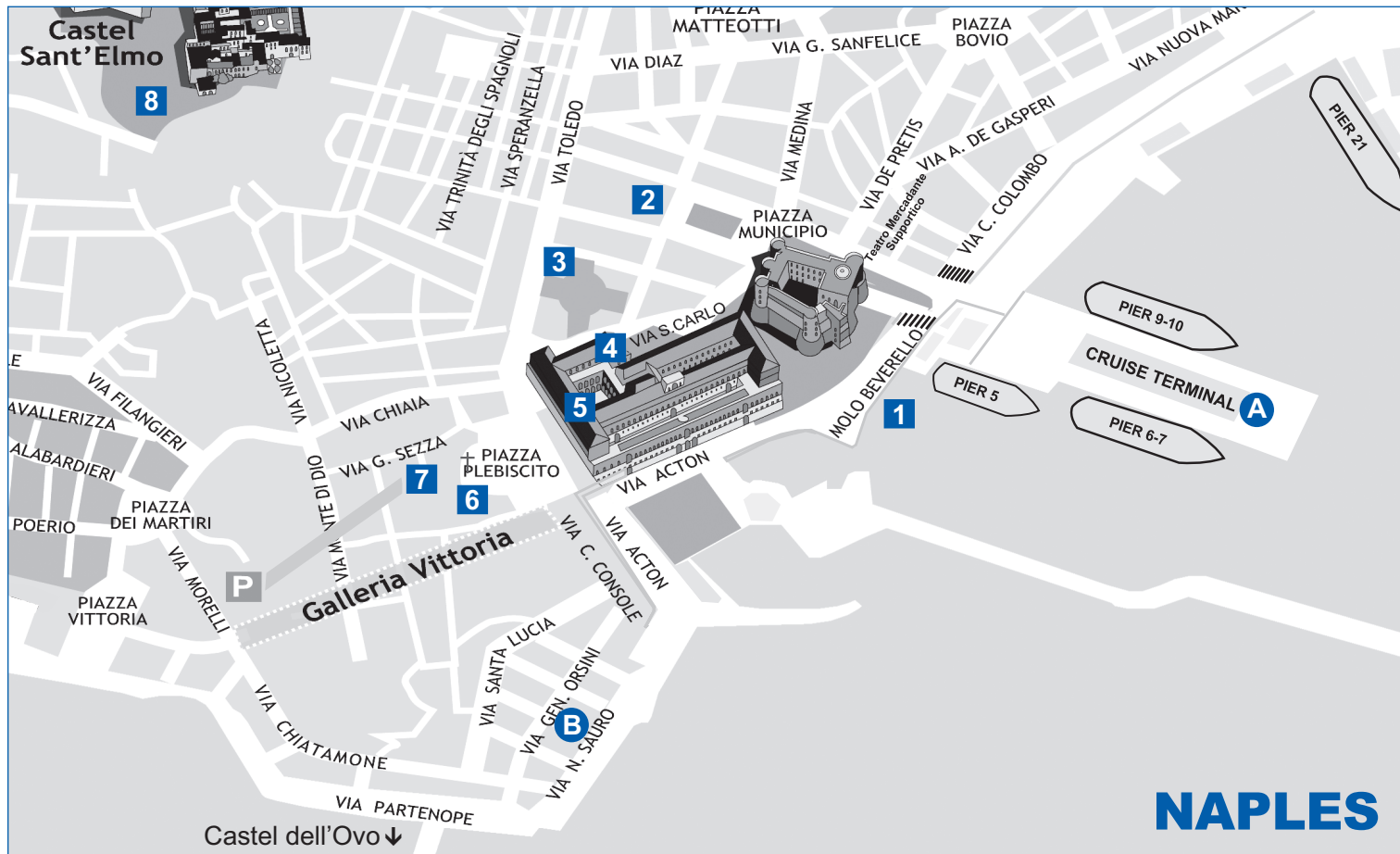

The SIGHTS, SHOPPING and DINING of NAPLES

The SIGHTS, SHOPPING and DINING of POMPEII



1 JET-FOIL TERMINAL

2 The **PALAZZO SAN GIACOMO** is the historic City Hall of Naples. The imposing neoclassical style building faces out over Piazza Municipio. King Ferdinand I of Bourbon ordered the constructed in the early 1800s.

3 The **GALLERIA UMBERTO I** was named in honor of the period's ruling king. The massive Galleria has four entrances, ornate arcades and a glass-arched dome which rises nearly 200 feet above the fine marble and mosaics floor.

4 The **SAN CARLO OPERA HOUSE** has a long, distinguished and dramatic history. The original San Carlo was inaugurated in 1737. Since then the San Carlo has burned down, been all but destroyed by bombing and nearly lost to neglect.

5 The **ROYAL PALACE OF THE BOURBON KINGS** dates to the 1600s. The elegant palace looks out over the broad Piazza del Plebiscito. The façade of the palace displays statues of the former rulers of the Kingdom of Naples. Today the palace houses a museum and the city's National Library.

6 **ST. FRANCIS BASILICA** (The Church of San Francesco di Paola) is the one of the most dramatic structures in Naples. Patterned after the Pantheon in Rome, the church was built in 1817 to celebrate the return of King Ferdinand I to the throne.

7 The **BOURBON UNDERGROUND MUSEUM** tells the story of the Bourbon Tunnel and Naples' amazing city beneath the city. Digging started in 1853 on the orders of King Ferdinand II. The tunnel served as a passage way for troops to reach the palace to protect the King as well as an escape route for the monarch.

8 **ST. ELMO CASTLE** looks out over Naples from high atop Vomero Hill. A small church dedicated to St Erasmus stood on this site for hundreds of years prior to being incorporated into a fortification in the late 1200s. Today, with its spectacular views of the sea, city and surrounding countryside, the restored castle is home to the Bruno Molajoli Art History Museum.

A GALLERIA DEL MARE

The Outlet Shopping Center "Galleria del Mare" (Sea Mall) offers its customers a wide variety of stores and services. You will find clothing, jewelry, antiques, fine furs, electronic, local products, wines and souvenirs shops. Grab a quick snack at their ice cream parlor or bars. There is also a Post Office, ATM machine and Internet services available.

B LA PIAZZETTA - 21/22, Via Nazario Sauro

Located on the Naples sea front, this charming restaurant has the best original Neopolitan pizza! Come and enjoy the real flavor of Naples only ten minutes walk from the ship along the beautiful sea front.



1 ENTRANCE / EXIT - Viale delle Ginestre

2 The **TEATRO GRANDE** (Grand Theater) was built in the 2nd century BC. In the 1st century AD, during the rule of Julius Caesar Augustus, the theater was expanded to hold an audience numbering 5,000. Today the wonderful theater has been restored to much of its original glory for live performances.

3 The **THEATRO PICCOLO** (Odeon) dates to around 80 BC. It is located next to the older and larger Teatro Grande.

6 The **SANTUARIO DELLA MADONNA DEL ROSARIO** (Our Lady of the Holy Rosary) was built in modern Pompeii in 1891 in tribute to the miracle of the Madonna del Rosario.

7 The **FORO** (The Forum) might be described as ancient Pompeii's town square. The large open area was surrounded by the Temple of Jupiter, the Temple of Apollo, public buildings, food markets, the Basilica and the Temple of Vespasian.

8 COFFEE SHOP / RESTAURANT

A DITTA GIOVANNI APA - 6 Via Cavallo

The fine art of creating exquisite cameos and coral jewelry has been practiced in the nearby town of Torre del Greco since the mid-1700s. A young master carver named Francisco Apa was eventually producing cameos and coral jewelry of such beauty the court of the Bourbon king became his royal patron. Ferdinand passed on his talent and vision to his son, Giovanni. After two centuries the name and international reputation of Giovanni Apa lives on through the skill of the devoted artisans who continue to create amazingly beautiful cameos and coral jewelry, still worthy of a King.



B CELLINI GALLERY FACTORY - 1 Piazza Porta Marina

The Cellini Galleria Factory offers charming millenary art, unique cameos and corals masterpieces.



C DONADIO CORALLI E CAMMEI SRL - 11 Piazza Porta Marina

Donadio Coralli e Cammei dates back to 1885 and the talented Gaetano Donadio who decided to follow his passion to create and sell beautifully decorated corals and finely carved cameos. This is one of the oldest artistic traditions in the region of Vesuvius. Today the cameos designed by our talented artists are transformed into unique charms by our master jewelers.



D DOMUS POMPEIANA - 11 Piazza Porta Marina

Visitors to Domus Pompeiana will find a wide selection of Italian made products. You can browse the Murano glass jewellery or perhaps order a pair of custom made sandals. Come visit the limoncello factory and taste our chocolate, biscuits and wines of Vesuvio.

6 **CERETOSA S. GIACOMO** dates to the mid-1300s. The site was originally a villa belonging to Roman Emperor Tiberius. In the 14th century, Carthusian monks built the monastery. The monastery has a Baroque tower, a number of cloisters and a few paintings from the 1600s.

7 **AUGUSTUS GARDENS** - Planted by order of Roman Emperor Caesar Augustus, these gardens are laid out in such a way as to compliment and highlight the dramatic beauty of the surrounding land and sea.

8 **FARAGLIONI ROCKS** - These three great rocks collectively known as The Faraglioni continue to survive the test of time and tempest. Given the names STELLA, FARAGLIONE DI MEZZO and FARAGLIONI DI FUORI, the impressive formations add beauty and drama to the landscape of Capri.

9 **S. MICHELE VILLA** - Villa St Michele was the beautiful home of a famous Swedish doctor by the name of Axel Munthe. Built high on the mountain-side overlooking the Gulf of Naples, the villa now serves as a Swedish cultural institution. .

10 CHAIR-LIFT STATION

11 **MT. SOLARO** rises nearly 2,000 ft. (589 meters) above the deep blue sea. Hikers can reach the summit in about 90 minutes. A chairlift is available for those who would rather relax and enjoy the scenic ride up the mountain. The panoramic view from atop Mount Solaro is simply spectacular.
